LICENCE COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

The Agawam License Commission held a Public Hearing on Wednesday April 15, 2026 at the Agawam Senior Center Conference Room, 954 Main Street, Agawam, MA. In attendance was Chairman Vincenzo Ronghi, Commissioner Katie Johnston along with Secretary Barbra Dobek, and former Councilman Peter Smus.

At 5:08 pm, a Public Hearing was held for: Flores Solis, Corp. dba: **KAPTAIN JIMMY'S**, Reynaldo Diaz, manager – 916 Suffield St., Agawam, MA – to transfer All Alcohol License with pledge of inventory and license, from A.D.E. ENTERPRISES, INC. Atty. Rickie Rizos represented both the seller and buyer of the transfer. She provided the secretary with original tear sheet and abutter green cards. Present was Antonios Rizos, and proposed new manager Ricardo Diaz. Vin Ronghi asked for the entity vote to be changed to read the new owners giving Ricardo Diaz permission to be the manager. Also to include a copy of updated articles of incorporation. They were told about the new Outdoor Dining permit required for the outdoor patio. The Liquor license does not cover the new Town of Agawam requirement. Be on the lookout for the recently mailed packet, and apply through the town. The application of transfer was approved 2-0, contingent that two additional documents which were requested are provided to the Clerk's Office. Upon receipt the application will be sent to the ABCC.

Riverside Park Enterprises, Inc, dba: **SIX FLAGS NEW ENGLAND** 1623 Main Street Agawam, MA- application for approval of both Automatic & Weekly Amusements. Both applications were seen separately. The Commission approved the Weekly Amusement 2-0, and the Automatic Amusement 2-0.

Junk Dealer's License applications were reviewed for **ROSATI MATERIALS, INC.** - 415 Silver St, Agawam, MA -all information was provided and it was approved 2-0, and for; **BLOCK JEWELERS, INC.**, 584 Meadow St, Agawam, MA – all information was provided and it was approved 2-0. The Commission questioned if we had heard back from Baki's Jewelry with a response to the second notice. Since we have not, they showed concern for the establishment as they will not be able to use the Junk Dealer's license until after the next scheduled ALC meeting in May.
